I.D. Premier™

Johnsonite's I.D. Premier™ is part of a system that balances impact across people, the environment and the bottom line. Our goal is to develop solutions that use better materials, practice resource stewardship, and create people-friendly spaces while maximizing reused and recycled content.

BETTER RAW MATERIALS

I.D. Premier is manufactured using the most environmentally responsible materials possible while assuring consistency in quality and performance. We use local suppliers as often as we can, to reduce the environmental impact from transportation.

- Based on up to 52% natural raw materials, such as mineral fillers.

RESOURCE STEWARDSHIP

I.D. Premier is produced in Clervaux, Luxembourg. The factory applies an environmental management system (ISO 14001) and over the last five years has made numerous improvements:

- Realized 14% reduction in VOC emissions to the air

The air from the factory is filtered through a biofilter where it is cleaned by bacteria. *All Johnsonite plants are externally audited for environmental risk assessment*

PEOPLE-FRIENDLY SPACES

One of our core beliefs is that people are happiest when they are offered choices that help them balance their needs and stay true to their values. I.D. Premier delivers valuable health, hygiene and welfare benefits:

- The PUR surface treatment reduces the use of water, detergent and chemicals, and ensures easy and low-cost cleaning and maintenance.
- Modular system for superior design flexibility
- FloorScore™ certified for good indoor air quality.

REUSE AND RECYCLE

Tarkett, parent company of Johnsonite, was one of the first flooring companies to recycle post-production waste, and has also developed a system for collecting post-installation waste. Clervaux is the recycling center for PVC-based floorcoverings in Western Europe, recycling more than 25,000 tons every year.

- I.D. Premier contains up to 41% pre-consumer recycled content.
- All samples can be reclaimed and repurposed as part of our ReStart® Reclamation Program.
- ReStart allows installers to send back unused or cut material for recycling.
